

Introducing ErasmusCareers.org, the new platform for international traineeships and jobs

After almost a decade of supporting international mobility and traineeships across Europe, ErasmusIntern.org has evolved into ErasmusCareers.org, a new platform designed to support students and organisations throughout the entire traineeship journey.

Erasmus Careers is now live, bringing traineeship and job opportunities together in a more unified European ecosystem. The new platform offers an improved user experience, enhanced profiles and new tools designed to make it easier for students to discover and apply for opportunities abroad, while helping organisations connect with prospective talent.

The transition marks more than a visual refresh. Erasmus Careers represents a new approach to how international traineeships are discovered, managed and supported, with features designed to improve transparency, quality and trust across the traineeship experience.

From finding an opportunity to completing a traineeship

Erasmus Careers has been designed to support the **full traineeship journey**, going beyond recruitment and matching. Alongside opportunities and applications, the platform introduces **guided support, quality assurance mechanisms** and **structured follow-up processes** to help both trainees and organisations make the most of their international experience.

For **students**, the new platform offers enhanced profiles where they can showcase their skills, experience and mobility background, as well as a unified view of job and traineeship opportunities. Its redesigned interface makes it easier to discover, apply for and manage opportunities, while new support and follow-up tools accompany students throughout their traineeship.

For **organisations**, Erasmus Careers provides upgraded company and opportunity pages, a streamlined onboarding process and tools to present opportunities more clearly to prospective candidates. A new system of quality labels and ratings, informed by research into traineeship quality, aims to make opportunities more transparent and trustworthy. Organisations can also monitor traineeship progress, collect feedback and support continuous quality improvement.

Building a more connected European traineeship ecosystem

International traineeships can offer valuable opportunities to develop professional skills, gain international experience and build connections across borders. However, students and organisations often navigate a fragmented landscape of platforms and processes.

Erasmus Careers aims to bring these experiences together in **one trusted European space**, connecting students and organisations while supporting quality throughout the traineeship cycle.

The platform also introduces enhanced security and verification processes and improved tools for matching opportunities with candidates, helping create a more reliable experience for everyone involved.

The transition from ErasmusIntern.org

The transition to Erasmus Careers is now underway.

ErasmusIntern.org is closed to new traineeship postings. Organisations wishing to publish new job or traineeship opportunities must now use [ErasmusCareers.org](https://www.erasmuscareers.org).

Existing ErasmusIntern.org users can access the new platform in two ways: users who have opted in to automatic migration will have their accounts transferred to Erasmus Careers starting mid-September. In contrast, those who prefer immediate access can create an account directly on the new platform.

For students, ErasmusIntern.org is closed to new account creation. Existing opportunities remain available for browsing and applications until the platform closes definitively at the end of 2026. All new activity is now moving to Erasmus Careers.

Students can access Erasmus Careers by visiting members.esn.org, creating an Erasmus Generation account and setting up their basic profile. They can then use the integrated authentication to log in to the platform. This authentication system is part of a wider effort to create a more connected experience across Erasmus Generation partner platforms.

With its launch, Erasmus Careers opens a new chapter for international traineeships in Europe, providing students and organisations with a dedicated space to discover opportunities, connect and build better mobility experiences.
